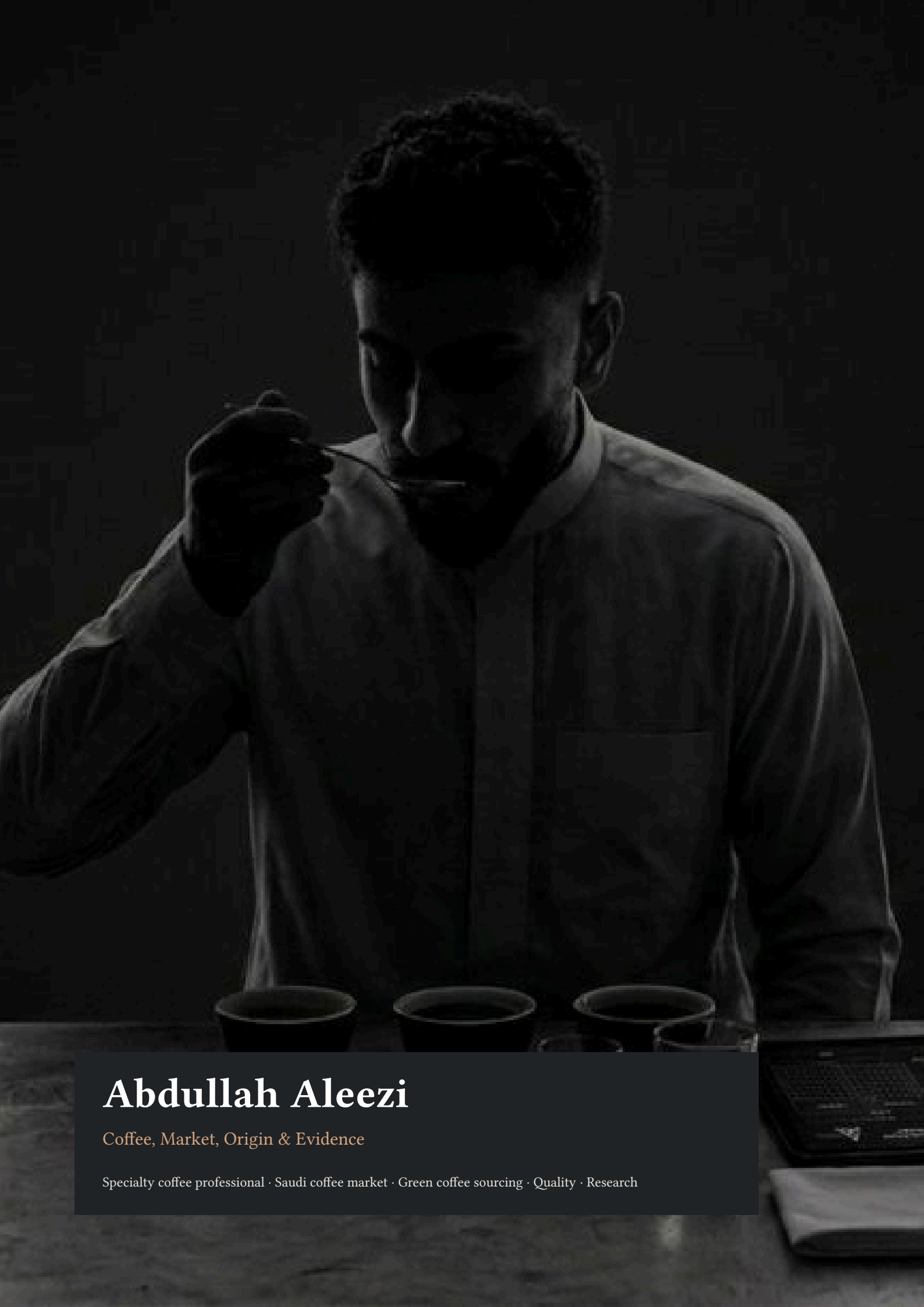


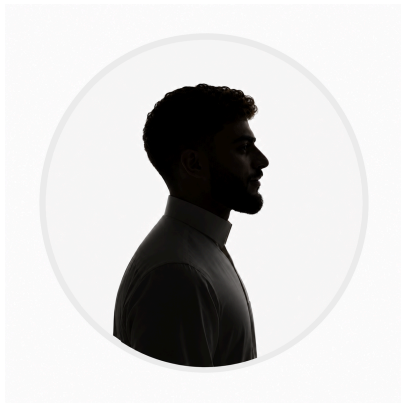

Alongside this market-facing work, I am developing a deeper research interest in Yemeni coffee, coffee history and the movement of Arabica across cultures and regions.

My work sits between the farm and the market, and between the sample and the buying decision.

Green Coffee Sourcing

Finding crops and supply options that fit a client's needs, market and commercial reality.

Reviewing the line from source to client: sourcing, evaluation, selection, negotiation and supply.

THE SUPPLY LINE

Sourcing → Evaluation → Selection → Negotiation → Supply → Client

The goal is not simply the highest-scoring coffee. It is the right coffee, at the right quality, for the right client and market.

RESEARCH & INVESTIGATION

I don't just taste coffee. I investigate it.

Research is one of the deepest parts of my relationship with coffee. I'm naturally drawn to questions that don't have obvious answers: why does this coffee taste this way? What happened before it reached the cup? What can history, genetics, processing, origin and sensory analysis tell us that tasting alone cannot?

I approach coffee with the mindset of an investigator — observing details, questioning assumptions, comparing evidence, tracing sources and connecting information that may initially seem unrelated.

4 From Mocha to Java

Reconstructing the Historical Migration of *Coffea arabica* from Yemen to Java

A research question I am developing: can modern genetic evidence help reconstruct the historical journey of Arabica coffee from Yemen toward Java?

I do not present this as a proven discovery, but as a research question to be developed with researchers, laboratories and specialist institutions.
